Adalbert (Wojciech) Dudek and Victoria (Wiktoría) Król were married on 9/22/1886 at the Catholic Parish located in Przeczyca.

They were both born in Zagórze within the Przeczyca Catholic Parish and still lived on the same farms. Adalbert, 22 years old, was from House #25 and Victoria, 23 years old, from House #13. Adalbert's parents were Gregory (Grzegorz) Dudek and Marianna Król, both born in Zagórze. Victoria's parents were Martin (Marcin) Król/Krul and Sophia (Zofia) Maziarka, both born in Dęborzyn, also within the Przeczyca Catholic Parish. It is unknown whether Victoria and her mother-in-law were related.

Victoria's family surname was consistently written as Krul in earlier records but changed to Król shortly after her birth in 1863. Her baptism was written with the Krul variation, but her marriage record and the baptisms of her children were written as Król. It is unclear whether this reflected a family preference or changes in how the church recorded birth, marriage, and death records over time. Both variations are accurate because that is how the records were written.

Their daughter Maryanna Dudek settled in Chicago, IL where she married Martin (Marcin) Byczek in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. They are Michael E. Byczek's great-grandparents. She and her brothers John and Stanley joined their maternal aunts Magdalena and Thecla (Tekla) along with other relatives from the Król and Dudek families.

Adalbert and Victoria Dudek remained at House #25 in Zagórze until their deaths in 1922 and 1936, respectively. It was the same farm where Adalbert had been born.

Some United States records identify Adalbert Dudek as George Dudek.

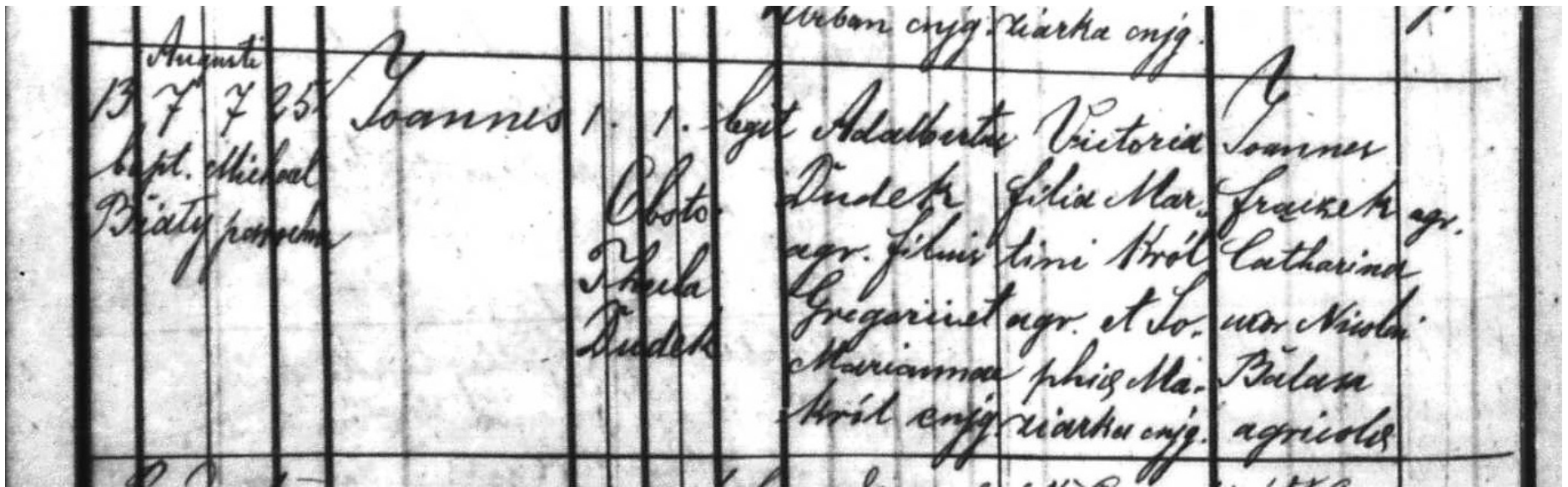
