Joachim Byczek and Lucy Kwilosz were married on 1/30/1804 at the Catholic church located in Osobnica. Joachim was born about 1783 and Lucy about 1787. Their place of birth is unclear. The only known information about their parents was that Lucy's father was Thaddeus Kwilosz. His name was written as Thadoso, which is presumed to refer to Thaddeus.

Their three known children were all born at House #118 Osobnica from 1809-1813. Jan Kwilosz owned House #118, as shown in the 1788 and 1820 land records. Documents show that Joachim Byczek became co-owner with Jan Kwilosz until the Byczek family later inherited full ownership of the farm. Joachim and Lucy Byczek's great-grandson Martin Byczek was born at House #118 in 1877. He is Michael E. Byczek's great-grandfather.

The land records do not include Thaddeus Kwilosz. It is possible that Jan Kwilosz was Lucy's grandfather or uncle. Thaddeus Kwilosz may have already passed away. However, these records have not been verified.

Joachim Byczek and Lucy Kwilosz had a total of three known children, all born at House #118:

Child	Date of Baptism	Godparents
Jacob Byczek	7/18/1809	Godmother is Agnes Byczek. Godfather is somewhat illegible.
Joseph Byczek	2/14/1812	Illegible. Looks like godmother is Agatha Byczek
Sophia Byczek	5/8/1813	Looks like godmother is Agnes Byczek

There may have been more children, whose baptism records have not yet been verified. Records for this time period do not show date of birth.

Their son Jacob Byczek married Catherine Dybas in 1842. They are Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents.

Joachim Byczek passed away in 1829 at House #118. Lucy's death has not been verified.

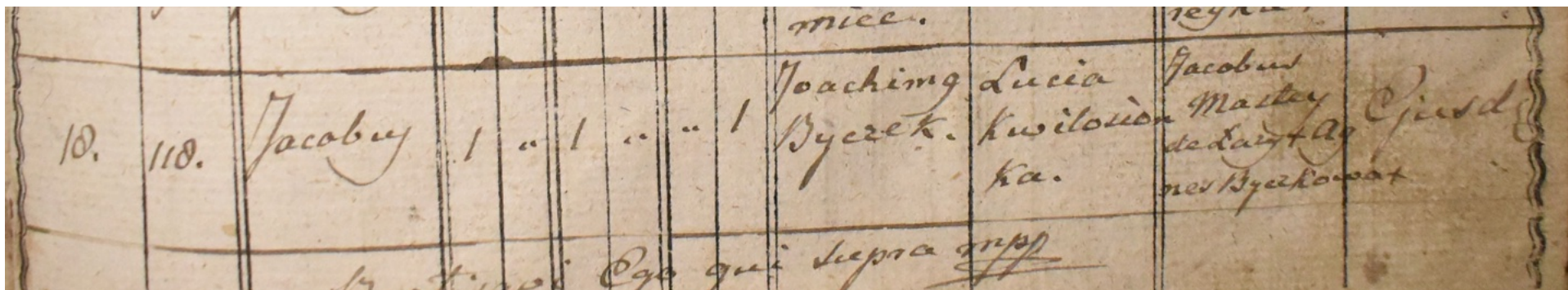

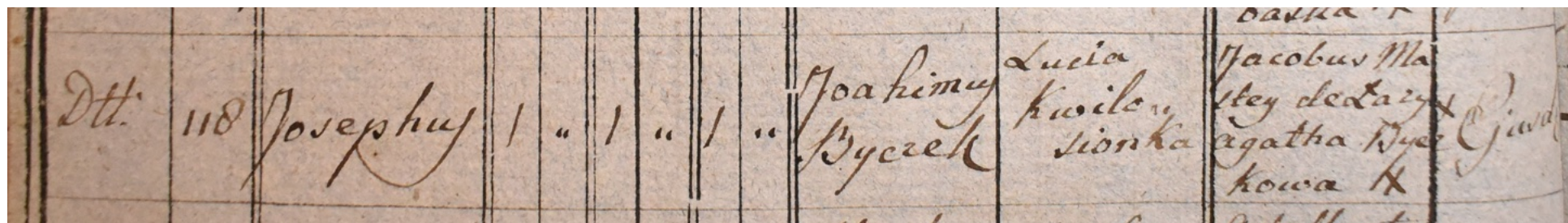

Joachim Byczek and Lucy Kwilosz are Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents. Their son Jacob Byczek (3x-great-grandfather) married Catherine Dybas in 1842. Their son Adalbert Byczek (2x-great-grandfather) married Catherine Czarny in 1874. Their son Martin Byczek (great-grandfather) married Maryanna Dudek in Chicago, IL at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their eldest child Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County, Subcarpathian Voivodeship, in south-eastern Poland.

Michael E. Byczek has been compiling actual records for the Osobnica Catholic Church Parish over the past ten or more years through direct messages to diocese archives and access to digitized microfilm. He has gathered an extensive collection of documents, including land ownership records. This compiled documentary is an accurate source of genealogy for Joachim Byczek and Lucy Kwilosz.
