

Roman Joseph Bykowski and Antoinette Agnes Murzynowicz

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Roman J. Bykowski was born on July 23, 1908 in Czarnotka within the Piotrkow Kujawski Catholic Parish in the Kuyavian-Pomeranian Voivodeship of north-central Poland. His parents were Joseph Bykowski and Margaret Piotrowski. He was baptized at the church located in Piotrkow Kujawski. Roman's middle name of Joseph is attributed to both his father and maternal grandfather. Joseph Bykowski traveled to Chicago, IL shortly after Roman's birth. Margaret (Piotrowski) Bykowski and Roman stayed with her parents in the nearby Witowo parish where the Piotrowski family lived. Joseph joined his brother-in-law Felix Piotrowski in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago and arrived during the Christmas holiday. Margaret and her son Roman traveled to Chicago in 1911 when Roman was three years old. Margaret's sister Charlotte Piotrowski traveled with them and lived with the Bykowski family until her own marriage. Joseph Bykowski owned and ran a neighborhood grocery store on Hoyne and Charleston during the 1910s and 1920s through Roman's early adulthood. The family lived in a few different locations, but are most associated with their residence in the same building as the grocery store at 2100 N. Hoyne and an apartment building at 1852 N. Damen, both in Bucktown. The family were parishioners of St. Hedwig Catholic Church on Damen and Hoyne in the same neighborhood.

Antoinette A. Murzynowicz was born on June 13, 1912 in Chicago while the family lived at 1214 N. Noble in the Pulaski Park neighborhood. She was the daughter of Frank Murzyn and Rose Sidor. Antoinette's parents had lived in Żubronajcie, a village within the Krasnopol Catholic Parish in the Podlaskie Voivodeship of north-eastern Poland. Antoinette's middle name of Agnes is attributed to her maternal grandmother. Prior to Antoinette's birth, the entire Murzyn family traveled back and forth between Żubronajcie and Chicago with children born and passed away in both locations. Frank Murzyn and his two brothers Adam and Walter were the first to travel to Chicago starting around 1898. Upon their arrival in Chicago, the brothers interchanged their last name between Murzynowicz and Marynowski. Frank's mother Josephine and two sisters Ursula and Emily also settled in Chicago. The entire Murzyn family lived near St. Stanislaus Kostka Catholic Church in Pulaski Park where Antoinette was baptized. Rose (Sidor) Murzyn's sister Anna Sidor and brother Michael Sidor also settled in Chicago. Antoinette's father formally changed his surname to Marynowski upon naturalization in 1925. Members of the family, especially Antoinette, continued using the surname Murzynowicz through the 1940s. The Murzynowicz/Marynowski family lived in several apartments in the Pulaski Park, Bucktown, and Wicker Park neighborhoods while Antoinette was growing up, but are most associated with the double lot they owned at 1625-27 N. Honore (Wicker Park).

Roman Bykowski and Antoinette Murzynowicz were married on June 13, 1936. The wedding took place at St. Stanislaus Kostka on Antoinette's 24th birthday. Roman was 27 years old. They met when Antoinette was visiting her married sister Adela's apartment near Paulina and Milwaukee in Wicker Park. Roman was visiting friends at the tavern across the street known as "Little Lady". Their first home after the wedding was at 946 N. Winchester in the East Village neighborhood of Chicago. The two-flat was owned by Antoinette's unmarried aunt Anna Sidor and was a focal point of several of Antoinette's siblings. Her sister Adela later lived next door. The Bykowski family remained at 946 N. Winchester until after Anna Sidor's death in 1961. Antoinette was one of her aunt's heirs with regard to ownership of the building when it was sold in 1963.

Roman and Antoinette Bykowski had three children. Their youngest, a daughter, Betty A. Bykowski married Michael M. Byczek in 1974 at St. Helen's in the Ukrainian Village neighborhood of Chicago. They are Michael E. Byczek's parents.

Roman Bykowski was naturalized as an American citizen in 1942. He worked as a die setter and punch press operator for most of his career. The company where he worked, from at least 1940 through retirement, was Jefferson Electric (part of Litton Industries) located in Bellwood, IL. Federal documents from 1940 listed his job as a punch press operator for electrical products at Jefferson Electric. Family memories are that Roman received a World War II draft deferment through his employment because the work was essential to the economy. The 1950 census listed his employment as a die setter for an electric appliance manufacturer. Roman's exact employment prior to 1940 is not known, but he spent time helping in the family grocery store early in his career.

Antoinette Murzynowicz helped her mother clean private residences on the north side of Chicago early in her career. The 1930 census listed her as a laborer at a print shop. She is best remembered as working at Goldblatt's Department Store on Chicago and Ashland (West Town neighborhood). Antoinette worked as a candy sales clerk at the store from about 1955-1977.

Roman and Antoinette Bykowski purchased a single family home at 3541 W. Hirsch in 1963 in the Humboldt Park neighborhood of Chicago. It was still the Bykowski family home when Roman passed away on 3/15/1983 at the age of 74 years old. Roman's funeral was held at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in the Ukrainian Village neighborhood, which was the family's primary church. Antoinette sold the house on Hirsch shortly after her husband's death. She spent about 20 years living in a 2nd floor apartment at 3406 N. Natchez in the Dunning neighborhood. Antoinette then spent the next several years living with her oldest daughter in Bolingbrook and the final years in assisted living at a facility in Itasca, IL near her son's residence. Antoinette passed away on 11/8/2006 in Itasca. She was 94 years old. Her funeral was held at St. Cornelius in the Jefferson Park neighborhood.

Roman and Antoinette Bykowski are buried next to each other at St. Adalbert's Catholic Cemetery in Niles, IL. Both of their parents along with Antoinette's grandmother Josephine (Muracki) Marynowski are also buried at St. Adalbert's.



At The Holy Baptism held today the child was given the name Roman and the godparents were Michał Sobczak and Władysława Piotroska.

This act was read aloud to the declarant and witnesses, all illiterate and signed only by us.



Czarnotka is in the lower left portion of the image with Piotrków Kujawski along the bottom near the left corner.


Roman's father lived in Niegibalice (center of image)


