This collective documentary covers the Chicago city directories from 1839-1928 with relevant analysis of the William and Julia Rooney family (Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents).

Their daughter Kittie A. Rooney married Edward H. Talbot (2x-great-grandparents) and are featured in the corresponding Thomas and Hannah Talbot Family documentary (Part 2/3).

The city directories are not always properly identified through online digitalized access to records with multiple versions that exist for the same period of years. Therefore, some entries might be inaccurate until more research is conducted to verify the precise year and publisher for each version of each directory.

Only relevant entires are included in this version of the documentary for simplicity. A more enhanced and comprehensive documentary is being compiled.

Michael E. Byczek has been researching the Chicago city directories since the early 1990s in physical paper format at local archive facilities. He has compiled a vast collection of digital copies that range from 1839 to 1928, including digitized White Pages through the 1970s.

INTRODUCTION.

We have no apology to offer in presenting a Directory thirtysix years after its original date. The new settler will see no use for it, but the "Old Settler" can read and refer to it with pleasure. It is hoped that the parties named in this work will never feel ashamed of the days when they earned an honest living "by the sweat of their brow."

"Honor and shame from no condition rise;
Act well your part—there all the honor lies."

In September, 1839, the Common Council ordered the revision and printing, in pamphlet form, of the Laws and Ordinances of the City. The work was tendered to Messrs. Rudd & Childs, printers, but they, not being able to find sufficient funds, offered to transfer the contract to the subscriber, who accepted and fulfilled it. There were six blank pages at the end, and Mr. Childs suggested the filling of them up with the names of the business men of the City, which was immediately done; no canvass was necessary, and the names were never written-each name, as thought of, was forthwith set up by the subscriber, until the six pages were completed. It never was supposed that the names of all the business men of the City were included in this list, but the necessary pages were filled up, and the title 'given those names the "CHICAGO BUSINESS DIRECTORY." There were no numbers on any street (except Lake Street,) at that time-the numbers now given are those of the present day.

On the completion of the Laws and Ordinances, fifty copies were delivered to the City, and the sum of \$25.00 was ordered paid, January 27th, 1840. (See Common Council Proceedings, published in the *Daily Chicago American*, Jan. 2, and 29, and February 22, 1840.)*

INTRODUCTION.

About fifty copies were sold to the citizens at fifty cents per copy; the balance of the 500 were never used in public.

This "Chicago Business Directory" was reprinted last year in pamphlet form, and a fancy history given to it. The subscriber began to complete the Directory, commenced in 1839, some two years ago, and can now say that our "Old Settlers" pronounce it complete. Had there not been incorrect statements made, by interested parties, perhaps this DIRECTORY never would have been printed; like the original, this never was canvassed for, or even written.

The first Directory of this City was carelessly canvassed for by James Wellington Norris, attorney, in the latter part of 1843. It was printed and published by William Ellis and Robert Fergus. The publishers had no trouble about the division of the profits of that speculation. Norris compiled three or four similar works in the years following, and, perhaps, with greater profit to all concerned.

The present publisher has since had some experience in Directories in this City. In 1854, 1855, and 1856 he again tried to place the Directory before the citizens in an improved form, but, unfortunately, his connections were not trustworthy, and, after considerable loss, he retired from the business.

In the compilation of this Directory, much assistance has been rendered by many of our old and intelligent citizens, for which the compiler returns sincere thanks.

This work has the sanction of Hon. John Wentworth, Hon. Julian S. Rumsey, Hon. Buckner S. Morris, Hon. Mahlon D. Ogden, James H. Rees, Esq., Joseph H. Gray, Esq., James A. Marshall, Esq., J. K. Botsford, Esq., Asahel Pierce, Esq., Peter Graff, Esq., Bennett Bailey, Esq., P. R. Morgan, Esq., and many other intelligent citizens, whose recollections of the days of 1839 are still bright.

Such additions or changes will be printed and furnished to purchasers of this Directory without charge, The Commemorative 1843 Directory was published in 1896 after the success of the 1839 Commemorative Directory.

William is referred to as a blacksmith and cross-referenced with his date of death. Therefore, something was found when these names were compiled that linked him to being a blacksmith.

It is presumed that O Rooney is Owen (William's brother) because he was married in Chicago in 1843. It would appear that he was living in Chicago when he first arrived, and since William was a blacksmith, perhaps he was also in the city at the time.

Rooney, O., laborer, res South Canal, bet Lake and Randolph Rooney, William, blacksmith, [died May 5, 1885, aged 711/8.

THE cordial reception and flattering endorsements given in 1876 to the Directory for 1839, by many of Chicago's oldest, well-known, and best-informed citizens, induced the compiler to undertake and to complete this little volume, begun over twenty years since, with the hope that it may be as well received.

The occupations given herein of many is no criterion as to their ability to follow other vocations. A graduate of Oxford, Eaton, Dublin, or Harvard, a lawyer without acquaintance, a poet, artist, and many similar professions would at that time find it difficult to obtain a livelihood, as all such were of very little use in our then embryo city.

The basis for this work was Chicago's first Directory of 1844, printed and published by Ellis & Fergus, from a careless and indifferent canvass made during 1843—August to December, by James W. Norris, and issued in December of that year.

One of the publishers, William Ellis who did the presswork of that volume, has been dead several years; the other is still here, and as he set the type, he knows how much he did for it and how much worse it would have been had he followed copy; but having been here over four years, he was somewhat acquainted with the business people in and about the business centre and in the vicinity of his home; the others—newcomers and those outside of the central part—he could do nothing for; and, as he later discovered, sailors were made tailors, and tailors sailors, names were spelled at and locations guessed, etc.; in

fact, the names of many prominent men were entirely omitted, or as inserted might as well have been, as those for whom they were intended could not recognize them.

Some of the dates of death, as herein given, have been found to conflict with those of interested parties and relatives; but so far, in every instance, on investigation they have been found to be correct. The identity of the dates of many of those known to be dead has been difficult, and several instances have occurred where more than one date applies to the same name, and until identified will not be inserted.

That all errors are now corrected, all omitted names inserted, or that new errors have not been made, is not claimed; but, with the additions and alterations herein made, it is believed to be very much improved; and if those who can will assist in this labor of love by forwarding as early as possible for the next edition any correction or error they may discover or any omission they may know of, they will no doubt have the thanks of posterity, but certainly those of your humble servant,

It is presumed this is still Owen, the only Rooney in Chicago at the time (William was probably more associated with the farm in Des Plaines, such as on a seasonal basis).












1886 Robinson Map




Proximity of 387 Division between Sedgwick (left) and Wells (right)




1892 Rascher's Map




1857 Map showing location of Hinsdale and Sedgwick in proximity to Chicago Ave Bridge (Hinsdale is red lettered street in center of image).

This collective documentary covers the Chicago city directories from 1860-1928 with relevant analysis of the Thomas and Hannah Talbot family (Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents).

Their son Edward H. Talbot married Kittie A. Rooney (2x-great-grandparents). Kittie's parents were William and Julia Rooney, who are featured in their corresponding documentary (Part 1/3).

The city directories are not always properly identified through online digitalized access to records with multiple versions that exist for the same period of years. Therefore, some entries might be inaccurate until more research is conducted to verify the precise year and publisher for each version of each directory.

Only relevant entires are included in this version of the documentary for simplicity. A more enhanced and comprehensive documentary is being compiled.

Michael E. Byczek has been researching the Chicago city directories since the early 1990s in physical paper format at local archive facilities. He has compiled a vast collection of digital copies that range from 1839 to 1928, including digitized White Pages through the 1970s.

One version of 1865-6 is online while a different version (probably different publisher for the same year span) was obtained from microfilm (2nd column). This second version creates the same confusion about which Thomas is correct. The listing for the Talbut spelling suggests that the correct Thomas was a railroad moulder at ICRR.

This collective documentary covers the Chicago city directories from 1880-1928 with relevant analysis of the Patrick and Anna Flanagan family (Michael E. Byczek's 2x-great-grandparents).

Their son Martin J. Flanagan married Marie T. Talbot in 1922 (great-grandparents). Marie was the daughter of Edward H. Talbot and Kittie Rooney, whose families are featured in Parts 1 and 2 of this three part documentary.

The city directories are not always properly identified through online digitalized access to records with multiple versions that exist for the same period of years. Therefore, some entries might be inaccurate until more research is conducted to verify the precise year and publisher for each version of each directory.

Only relevant entires are included in this version of the documentary for simplicity. A more enhanced and comprehensive documentary is being compiled.

Michael E. Byczek has been researching the Chicago city directories since the early 1990s in physical paper format at local archive facilities. He has compiled a vast collection of digital copies that range from 1839 to 1928, including digitized White Pages through the 1970s.

A few surname variations are included, such as Flanagan, Flanagan, and Flanagan, and Flanagan along with Kane and Keane.

Patrick Flanagan's father James died in Port Huron, MI (most likely place of death) in 1882. Patrick is listed in the 1883 Port Huron Directory (only appearance). He was married in Chicago in 1886. Therefore, it's presumed that he arrived in Chicago between 1883-1886.

Patrick's sister Catherine married William Hogwood in Chicago in 1880, while her father was still alive in Port Huron. Hogwood lived in Chicago on/off and doesn't always appear in the Directory.

Patrick's other sister Mary married Michael Hastings in Chicago in 1884, then married a second time in 1894 to William McCollough. He was from Port Huron. It's assumed she returned to Port Huron immediately after the second marriage, since her husband was working in Port Huron.

Patrick's brother John is listed in the Port Huron Directory and census through 1888. He got married in Chicago in 1889. He moved to Los Angeles sometime between 1900 and 1909.

Anna Kane settled in Chicago around 1883. It's unknown when her two brothers John and Martin arrived in Chicago.

Notes: The Patrick at 142 W. 18th shows up later, so it's probably too early for this address to be correct.

Notes: Anna spelled Flanagan and living at 1749 W. 59th. There are twelve (or eleven if Princeton a repeat) Martin possibilities. Two are Martin J. This is the year Marie was born and they were living at 3029 W 41st (In August). Since his initial was J, it seems reasonable to eliminate everybody with a specified initial. Of the remaining, Nebraska and Princeton are out. The J initial at Drexel is out. That leaves St. Paul, Lorel, and Bishop if Martin was living elsewhere than 41st when directory compiled. There was a Martin at the address on Bishop in 1917, so that is probably out. Lorel is too far north and probably not right. St Paul was Humboldt Park, which seems not.
