Paul Czarny and Marianna Paluch were married on 9/27/1830 at the Catholic church located in Osobnica. Paul was 27 and Marianna was about 18 years old.

Paul was the son of Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba from House #117 in Osobnica. He was baptized on 1/23/1803. The church records did not include date of birth.

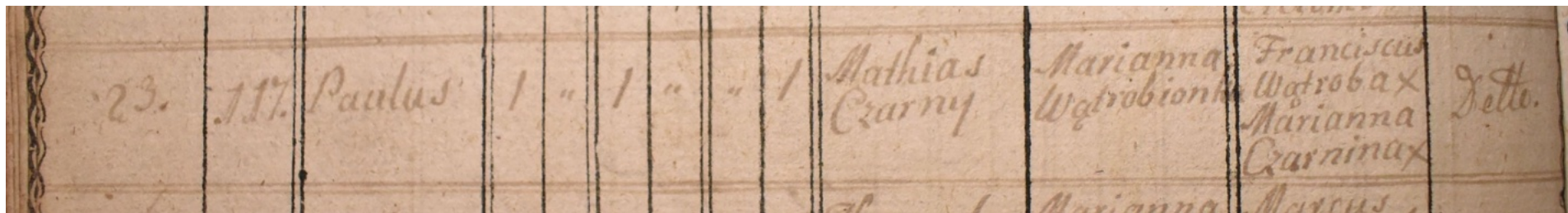
Marianna's place of birth is unknown. Her parents were Martin Paluch and Francisca Stachacz. She was born about 1812. The marriage record suggests that the Paluch family was living in Osobnica in 1830.

Paul Czarny and Marianna Paluch had nine known children, all born at House #117 in Osobnica:

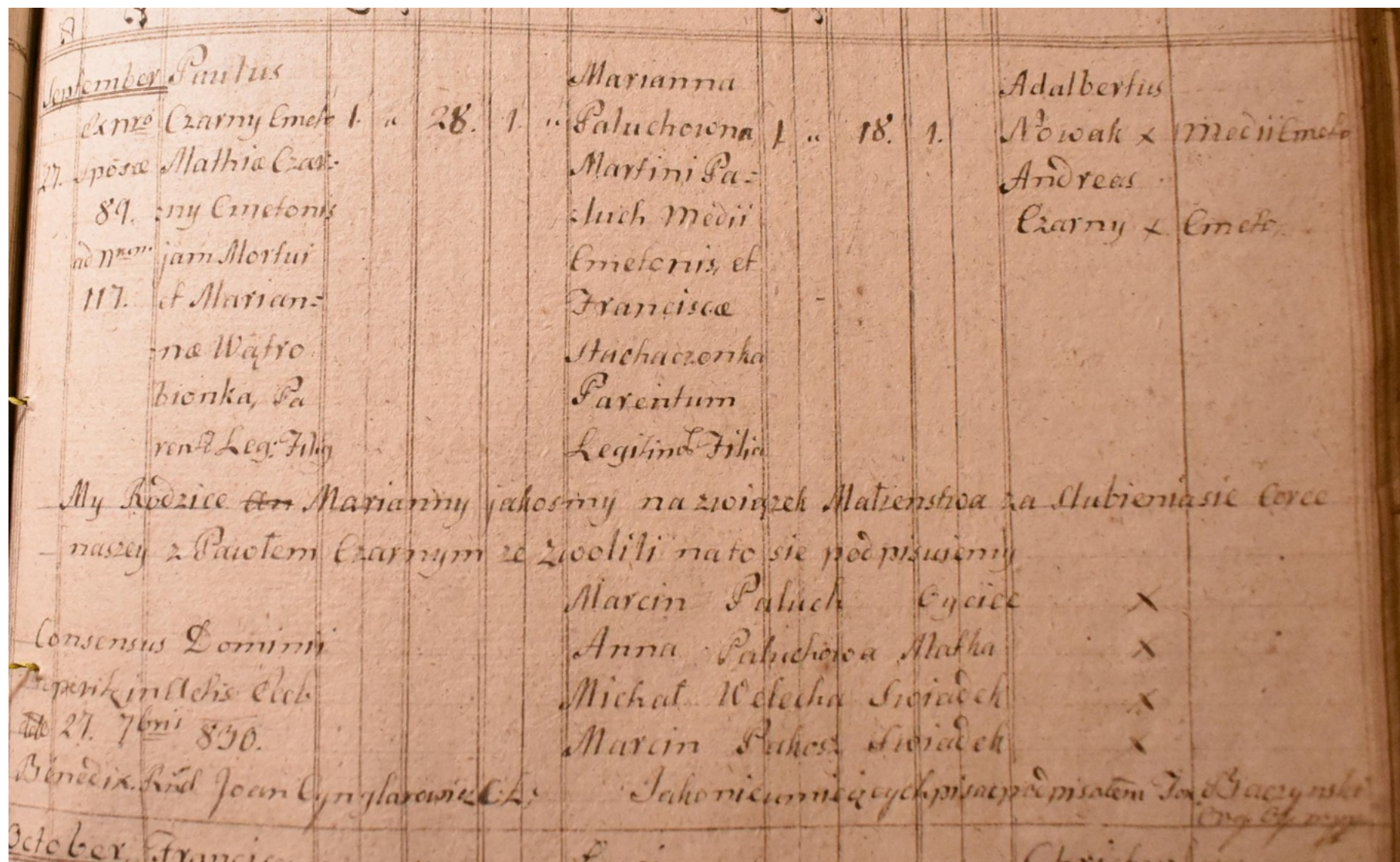

Their daughter Catherine Czarny married Adalbert Byczek in 1874 at the Osobnica church. They are Michael E. Byczek's 2x-great-grandparents. The Byczek family lived next door at #118 in Osobnica.

The death records for Paul Czarny and Marianna (Paluch) Czarny have not been verified.

 Paul was from #117 and Marianna lived at #89, both in Osobnica

Marianna's father consented to the marriage, but somebody named Anna Paluch is listed as mother without indication of whose mother. Since Paul's father is dead, it would make sense that his mother gave her consent. Marianna could have been written as Anna. However, she has the wrong surname. Perhaps, Paul's mother remarried?

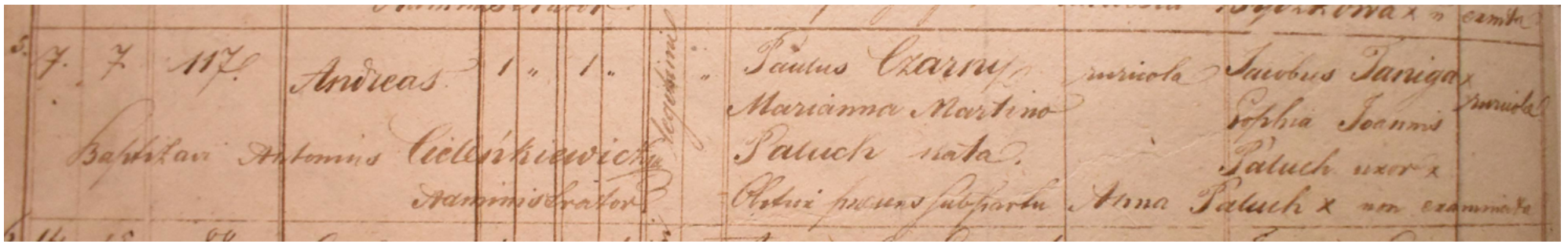

Paul Czarny and Marianna Paluch are Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents. Their daughter Catherine Czarny (2x-great-grandmother) married Adalbert Byczek in 1874 in Osobnica. Their son Martin Byczek (great-grandfather) married Maryanna Dudek in Chicago, IL at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their son Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County, Subcarpathian Voivodeship, in south-eastern Poland.

Michael E. Byczek has been compiling actual records for the Osobnica Catholic Church Parish over the past ten or more years through direct messages to diocese archives and access to digitized microfilm. He has gathered an extensive collection of documents, including land ownership records. This compiled documentary is an accurate source of genealogy for Paul Czarny and Marianna Paluch.
