

## Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba

Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba were married on 1/28/1793 at the Catholic church located in Osobnica.

Records suggest that Mathias was the son of Jacob and Anne Czarny. His mother's maiden name has not been verified. The most likely baptism record for Mathias was 2/12/1769 in Osobnica. Based on the marriage record, Mathias was born in 1768. There is a matching baptism record in 1769, but it's unknown whether there were multiple Mathias Czarny baptisms in or near Osobnica at the same time. Mathias was living at #256 in Osobnica when he got married in 1793. The 1788 land records show that Anna Czarny owned the property, which could indicate she was a widow. The marriage record does not specifically identify whether it was the bride or groom who lived at #256, but since the property was owned by a Czarny family, it is presumed to have been the groom.

Records suggest that Marianna was the daughter of Michael and Margaret Watroba. Her mother's maiden name has not been verified. The most likely baptism record for Marianna was 3/19/1778 in Osobnica. Church documents confirm that Marianna's father was Michael Watroba but do not list her mother's name. The marriage record listed Marianna as 16 years old, with an estimated year of birth as 1777. The baptism record from 1778 shows that Michael and Margaret Watroba had a daughter named Marianna.

Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba had 12 known children, all born at House #117 in Osobnica:



Their son Paul Czarny married Marianna Paluch in 1830 at the church in Osobnica. They are Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents. Joachim Byczek and his wife Lucy (Kwilosz) Byczek, godparents listed above, are Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents who lived next door at #118 in Osobnica.

The death records for Mathias Czarny and Marianna (Watroba) Czarny have not been verified.





Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba are Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents. Their son Paul Czarny (3x-great-grandfather) married Marianna Paluch in 1830 in Osobnica. Their daughter Catherine Czarny (2x-great-grandmother) married Adalbert Byczek in 1874 in Osobnica. Their son Martin Byczek (great-grandfather) married Maryanna Dudek in Chicago, IL at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their son Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County, Subcarpathian Voivodeship, in south-eastern Poland.

Michael E. Byczek has been compiling actual records for the Osobnica Catholic Church Parish over the past ten or more years through direct messages to diocese archives and access to digitized microfilm. He has gathered an extensive collection of documents, including land ownership records. This compiled documentary is an accurate source of genealogy for Mathias Czarny and Marianna Watroba.
