Sebastian Dybas and Catherine Nowak were married on 2/25/1805 at the Catholic church located in Osobnica.

Records suggest that Sebastian was the son of Peter and Catherine Dybas and that he was baptized on 1/20/1782. His mother's maiden name is unknown. Sebastian was from House #181 in Osobnica. Land records show that Peter Dybas owned House #181 in Osobnica when Sebastian would have been born.

There were at least two individuals named Sebastian Dybas who were about the same age. Baptism records show that Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandfather Sebastian Dybas asked another Sebastian Dybas to act as godfather multiple times.

Catherine's place of birth is unknown. Records show that her father was Paul Nowak and that she was born about 1786.


Sebastian Dybas and Catherine Nowak had 13 known children, all born at House #181 in Osobnica:

[*] Church records did not list date of birth until Salomea in 1818. The dates marked with [*] refer to date of baptism. Afterwards, the actual date of birth is listed.

Their daughter Catherine Dybas married Jacob Byczek in 1842 at the church in Osobnica. They are Michael E. Byczek's 3x-great-grandparents.


The death records for Sebastian Dybas and Catherine (Nowak) Dybas have not been verified.

Godparents are slightly illegible.

It would appear that the address is #181, which is correct.
It's also possible that the address is meant to be #101.

While a good match for the marriage record, it is unknown whether there were multiple such families at the same time in Osobnica.

It is unclear whether the address is meant to be #187 or #107.
It's also unknown whose address was listed, the bride or groom.


This marriage record is a match for their first and last names.
However, without definitive family cross-reference, it's possible there were two families with the same maiden names at the same time in Osobnica.






1820 Baptism of Francisca Dybas

Additional Information

Sebastian Dybas and Catherine Nowak are Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents. Their daughter Catherine Dybas (3x-great-grandmother) married Jacob Byczek in 1842 in Osobnica. Their son Adalbert Byczek (2x-great-grandfather) married Catherine Czarny in 1874 in Osobnica. Their son Martin Byczek (great-grandfather) married Maryanna Dudek in Chicago, IL at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their son Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County, Subcarpathian Voivodeship, in south-eastern Poland.

Michael E. Byczek has been compiling actual records for the Osobnica Catholic Church Parish over the past ten or more years through direct messages to diocese archives and access to digitized microfilm. He has gathered an extensive collection of documents, including land ownership records. This compiled documentary is an accurate source of genealogy for Sebastian Dybas and Catherine Nowak.
