Frank and Rosalie Nowakowski raised their family in Opatowice within the Radziejow Catholic parish. Rosalie's maiden name is unknown. The best estimate for Frank's birth is 1722 and Rosalie is 1736.

At least four children have been identified:

Rosalie Nowakowski passed away in 1796 and Frank Nowakowski in 1803 while both were living in Opatowice. These are the best candidate death records for the family.

Opatowicz. This took place in the city of Kołobrzeg on the twenty-first day of February, 1840, at nine o'clock in the morning.

32. Jan Nowakowski, forty years old, and Wimińky, twenty-seven years old, both farmers, settled in Opatowice, appeared and declared that on the twentieth day of this month, at ten o'clock in the evening, Jan Nowakowski, a Catholic, a farmer born in Opatowice, died, and his wife, Rozała Nowakowski, seventy years old, left a beautiful wife, Bygih, from Gralilwez. After learning of Nawaleie's death, this act was read by the presenters, who were not able to write.

Frank and Rosalie Nowakowski are Michael E. Byczek's 6x-great-grandparents. Their son John Nowakowski (5x-great-grandfather) married Bridget Mętlewicz in 1793 in Radziejow. Their son Vincent Nowakowski (4x-great-grandfather) married Hedwig Mordel in 1827 in Radziejow. Their son John Nowakowski (3x-great-grandfather) married Catherine Kocinski in 1857 in Radziejow. Their daughter Victoria Nowakowski (2x-great-grandmother) married Joseph Piotrowski in 1876 in Radziejow. Their daughter Margaret Piotrowski (great-grandmother) married Joseph Bykowski in 1907 in Witowo prior to settling in Chicago, IL. Their son Roman Bykowski (grandfather) arrived in the United States when he was three years old. The family lived in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago. Roman married Antoinette Murzynowicz/Marynowski in 1936 at St. Stanislaus Kostka in the Pulaski Park neighborhood. Their daughter Betty A. Bykowski (mother) married Michael M. Byczek in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood.
