Casimir Gorzycki and Helen Kosięta lived in Płowki within the Broniewo Catholic parish. The village appears to have also been within the Chelmce parish in earlier years.

The best estimate for their birth is about 1749 and their marriage around the early 1770s. The place of their births and marriage is unknown.

Helen's maiden name of Kosięta is not verified (nor the precise spelling), but is the best candidate at present time. It appears that her father was Adalbert Kosieta. Other possible spelling variations could include Kosicka, Kosecki, Koszytkowski, and Kosiatkowski.

Casimir Gorzycki's father appears to have been John Gorzycki.

There are four known children of Casimir Gorzycki and Helen Kosięta:

Their daughter Catherine Gorzycki married Ignatius Lasocki in 1808 at the Broniewo church. They are Michael E. Byczek's 5x-great-grandparents.

Helen Gorzycki passed away in 1828 while the family still lived in Płowki within the Broniewo parish. Casimir Gorzycki passed away the following year, also in Płowki. On balance of probabilities, these are the correct death records versus another family in the same village with the same names. Helen's maiden name does not appear in these documents.

From the Kleparski War, the Commander of the Broncow Family
It took place in the village of Broniewo on February twenty-second,
eighteen hundred twenty-eight, at eight o'clock in the morning.
Franceszek Gornycki, a fifty-one-year-old farmer, and Andrzej Stanny, a
thirty-year-old farmer, residing in Płowki, appeared and declared that on
the twentieth day of the current month, at seven o'clock in the morning,
Helena Gornyska, an eighty-two-year-old worker, who lived in Płowki,
died, leaving behind her widowed husband, Kaznirz Grzyski, who lived
in Płowki. After being convinced by my own eyes of Grzyska's death,
this act was read to the presenters and signed by me personally, since
the presenters cannot write. X Wojciech Kliparski, Commander of the

This happened in the village of Broniewo on the eleventh day of September, 1829, at eight o'clock in the morning. Franciszek Gorzyski, a landlord residing in Płock, fifty years old, and Alugustyn Gorzydki, a landlord residing in Płock, fifty-two years old, appeared and declared that on the tenth day of this month at midnight, Kazimierz Gorzyski, a landlord residing in Płock, eighty years old, had died. Additional Information

Casimir Gorzycki and Helen Kosięta are Michael E. Byczek's 6x-great-grandparents. Their daughter Catherine Gorzycki (5x-great-grandmother) married Ignatius Lasocki in 1808 in Broniewo. Their daughter Elizabeth Lasocki (4x-great-grandmother) married Valentine Kocinski in 1828 in Piotrkow Kujawski. Their daughter Catherine Kocinski (3x-great-grandmother) married John Nowakowski in 1857 in Radziejow. Their daughter Victoria Nowakowski (2x-great-grandmother) married Joseph Piotrowski in 1876, also in Radziejow. Their daughter Margaret Piotrowski (great-grandmother) married Joseph Bykowski in 1907 in Witowo prior to settling in Chicago, IL. Their son Roman Bykowski (grandfather) arrived in the United States when he was three years old. The family lived in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago. Roman married Antoinette Murzynowicz/Marynowski in 1936 at St. Stanislaus Kostka in the Pulaski Park neighborhood. Their daughter Betty A. Bykowski (mother) married Michael M. Byczek in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood of Chicago.

- Chełmce is located opposite to Płowki about the same distance as the village is from Broniewo.
