## Luke Lasocki and Agnes Szucharski

Luke and Agnes Lasocki lived in Lupsin within the Piotrkow Kujawski Catholic parish. There are very few documents about their family to verify genealogical information.

The best estimate for when Luke Lasocki was born is 1747.

Only one child has been identified, a son Ignatius Lasocki, who married Catherine Gorzycki in 1808 in Broniewo. They are Michael E. Byczek's 5x-great-grandparents.

There is uncertainty as to the name of Ignatius Lasocki's mother. His marriage record listed Maryanna Szucharski. The best candidate for his baptism shows the name of Agnes without a maiden name. The best candidate for his father's death record listed his wife as Agnes Sypiewski.

At present, Michael E. Byczek has determined that Agnes Szucharski is a good reflection for the identity of Ignatius Lasocki's mother

When Ignatius Lasocki was married in 1808, it appears that his baptism was verified. This verification process for the marriage listed Maryanna Szucharski/Szacharski as his mother. However, there is only one candidate for his baptism. That document showed Agnes without a maiden name. There are the only two documents that identify the mother of Ignatius Lasocki. One is Agnes and the other is Maryanna. On balance of probabilities, the baptism (Agnes) is more likely to be correct than the marriage record (Maryanna).

Luke Lasocki passed away in 1827 while living in Lupsin. His wife was listed as Agnes Sypiewski. It is possible that his wife at the time of death was not Ignatius's mother, as he could have been married multiple times. It could just be a coincidence that the name of a subsequent wife was also Agnes.

The surnames of Sypiewski and Szucharski are similar to have, perhaps, been spelled phonetically.

Luke Lasocki and Agnes Szucharski are Michael E. Byczek's 6x-great-grandparents. Their son Ignatius Lasocki (5x-great-grandfather) married Catherine Gorzycki in 1808 in Broniewo. Their daughter Elizabeth Lasocki (4x-great-grandmother) married Valentine Kocinski in 1828 in Piotrkow Kujawski. Their daughter Catherine Kocinski (3x-great-grandmother) married John Nowakowski in 1857 in Radziejow. Their daughter Victoria Nowakowski (2x-great-grandmother) married Joseph Piotrowski in 1876, also in Radziejow. Their daughter Margaret Piotrowski (great-grandmother) married Joseph Bykowski in 1907 in Witowo prior to settling in Chicago, IL. Their son Roman Bykowski (grandfather) arrived in the United States when he was three years old. The family lived in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago. Roman married Antoinette Murzynowicz/Marynowski in 1936 at St. Stanislaus Kostka in the Pulaski Park neighborhood. Their daughter Betty A. Bykowski (mother) married Michael M. Byczek in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in the Bridgeport neighborhood of Chicago.
