

## John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski

John (Jan) Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski (Ewa Czarnawska) raised their family in Dęborzyn within the Przeczyca Catholic Parish in southeastern Poland. They were probably married at the church in Przeczyca, or nearby, around 1784.

John was born about 1752 and Eva about 1759. The identities of their parents and their place/date of birth are unknown. They were associated with several Maziarka and Czarnawski families in Dęborzyn. While it is not possible at present to determine the exact family relationships, these records as a collective reveal significant insight into their closest relatives.

Their son Valentine Maziarka married Clara (Klara) Przybylo in 1821 at the church located in Pilzno. They lived at House #12 in Dęborzyn after the wedding and are Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents. Valentine Maziarka passed away in 1830, which was too early for detailed church records to show the names of his parents. However, the following verified facts suggest, on the balance of probabilities, that John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski are Michael E. Byczek's 5x-great-grandparents:

1. Valentine and Clara Maziarka lived at House #12 Dęborzyn after their marriage until both of their deaths.
2. Clara Maziarka remarried and remained at House #12.
3. There is only one viable birth record for a Valentine Maziarka within the right age range. The parents were John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski.
4. Half of all known children of John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski were born at House #12
5. The most likely death record for John Maziarka was at House #12 while Valentine's children and widow, Clara Maziarka, were still living on the same farm.

The most likely death records for Eva (Czarnawski) Maziarka was in 1819 at House #10 Dęborzyn and for John Maziarka in 1832 at House #12 Dęborzyn.

## **The Maziarka Families of Dęborzyn**

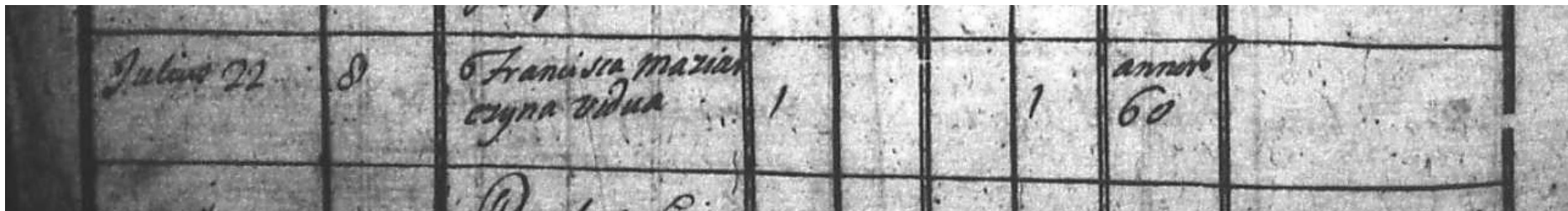
There were several Maziarka families living near each other at Houses #7, 8, 10, and 12 in Dęborzyn. The John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski was directly associated with the families who lived on these farms. The earliest available records for John and Eva are at House #8. They settled at House #12 after briefly living at Houses #9 and #10.

Online access to digitized records start in 1786. John and Eva had a son born in that year. It's possible that they had older children, since the date of their marriage is unknown.

Representative documents are shown below.

*Francisca Maziarka (House #8)*

A widow named Francisca Maziarka passed away in 1791 at House #8 during the time period that John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski lived on the same farm. She was 60 years old with an estimated year of birth as 1731. While it's possible that Francisca was John's mother, it is equally possible that she was a step-mother or aunt (i.e. her deceased husband was John's uncle). The fact that two families with the same surname lived on the same farm at about the same time does not prove they were mother and son. Land records show that John Maziarka owned the farm around the time that Francisca died. However, shortly afterwards, Stanley Maziarka acquired ownership. It seems unusual that John and Eva Maziarka would have lost ownership of their farm to a relative named Stanley with the result that they had to leave the property. It seems more likely that the John Maziarka in the ownership records was the husband of Francisca. It would have been a coincidence that another John Maziarka lived on the same farm. Tax records for 1773 show one Maziarka in the area named Valentine, who may have been related to Francisca.

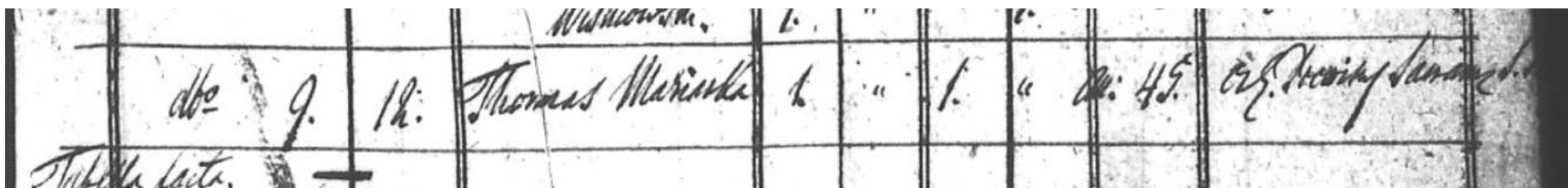


1791 Death of Francisca Maziarka

*Thomas Maziarka (House #12)*

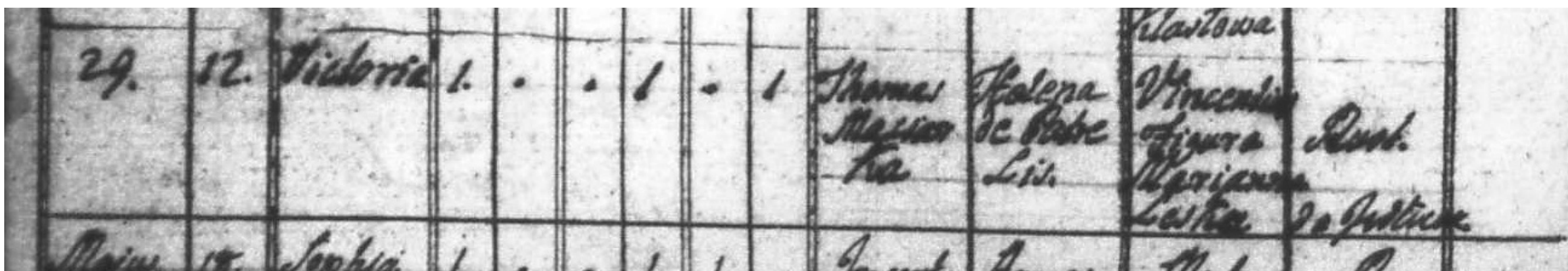
Land ownership records show that Thomas Maziarka owned House #12 during the time when the John and Eva Maziarka family lived on the farm. It is possible that Thomas was their older son who was born earlier than 1786. Thomas Maziarka died (age 45) in 1822. He would have been born in 1777. Based on death records, John was 25 years old and Eva was 18. It is possible that Thomas was their son, but this cannot be determined at present. It would explain why John and Eva's son Valentine was associated with ownership of House #12 if he acquired the land after the death of his own brother.

Thomas Maziarka was married to Helena Lis. They were married in 1804 in Przeczyca, but the original record does not appear to be accessible online.

*Margaret Maziarka (House #12)*

There is an illegible death record for Margaret Maziarka at House #12 in 1806. The last name looks like Maziarka. If so, Margaret was 56 years old (possibly 50). Therefore, she was born in 1750. John Maziarka was born in 1752. The death record does not indicate whether she was married (unless the spelling of the last name is a clue). For instance, Margaret could have been John's unmarried sister or the mother of Thomas Maziarka who owned the farm.

*Michael Maziarka (House #8, #10)*

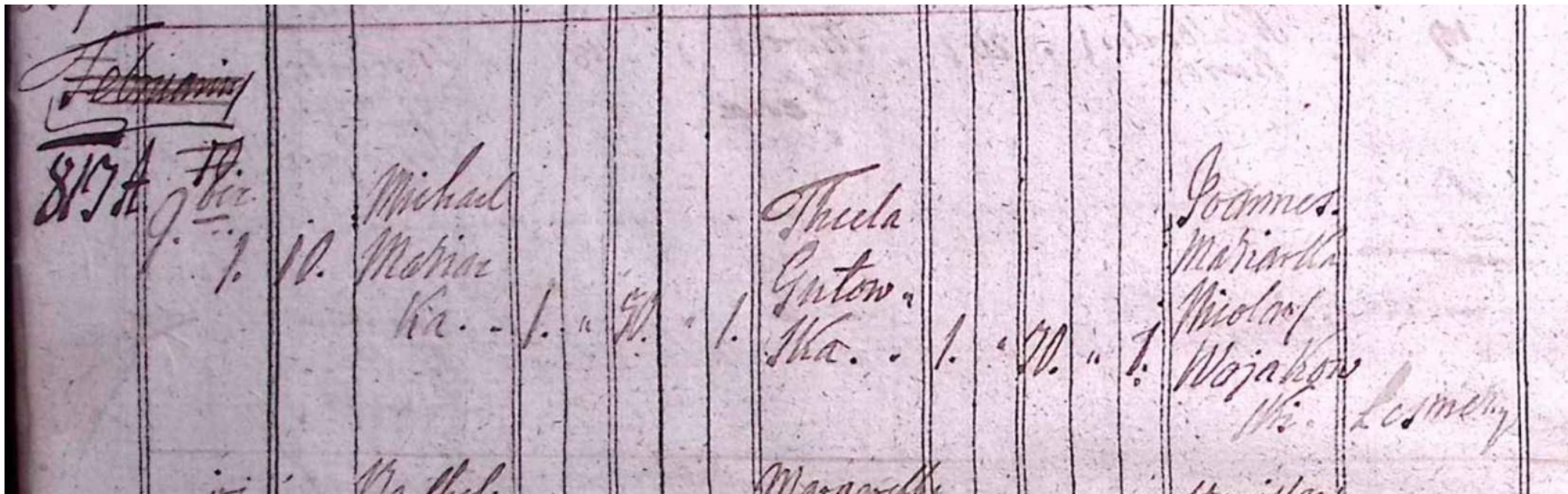
Clara (Przybylo) Maziarka married Michael's son Jacob as a widow. Both of her husbands, Valentine and Jacob, were born at the same house (#8). That suggests that their fathers John and Michael were related, perhaps cousins. John and Eva Maziarka were already living at House #8 when Michael Maziarka was still living at House #7. Michael and Marianna Maziarka first appear at House #8 at about the same time that John and Eva Maziarka moved to House #12. It is unclear whether the two families ever lived on the same farm at the same time.

Michael's first wife was Marianna Kolek (Kotek). Their marriage was listed for House #7, which was owned by Bartholomew Maziarka. Their timeline for which farms their children were born on was House #7, #8, and #10. Eva (Czarnawski) Maziarka appears to have died at House #10 in 1819.

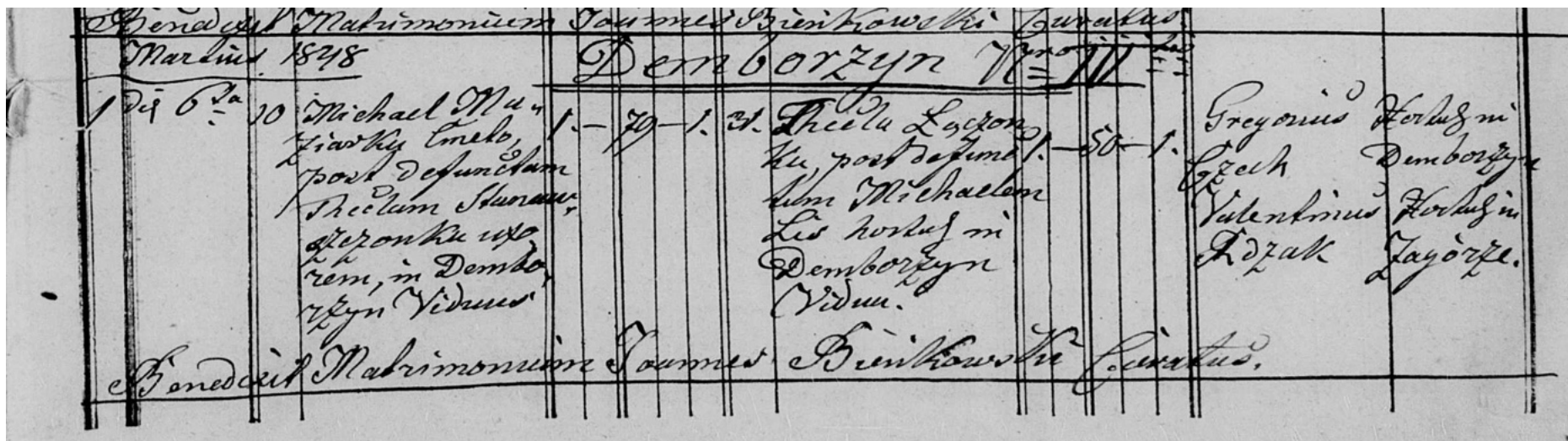
1791 Marriage of Michael Maziarka

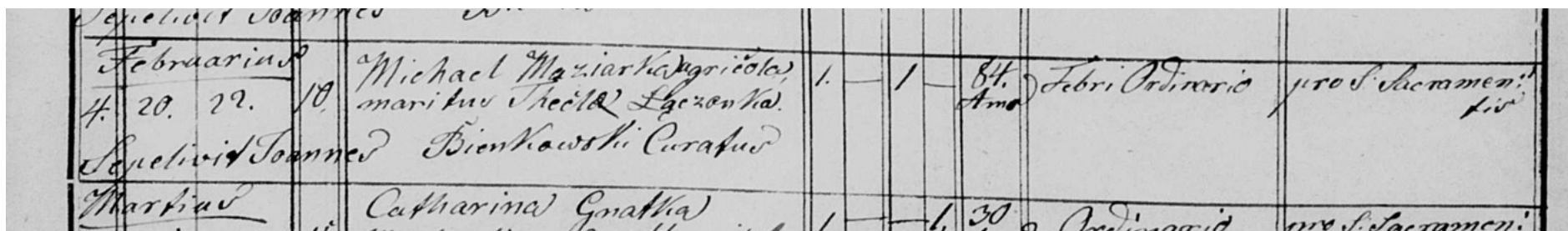

The Martin Cech and Regina Maziarka family lived in House #10. In 1809, the godmother for one of their daughters was Eva Maziarka (wife of John). It appears that Michael Maziarka may have acquired ownership of the farm from Martin Cech.

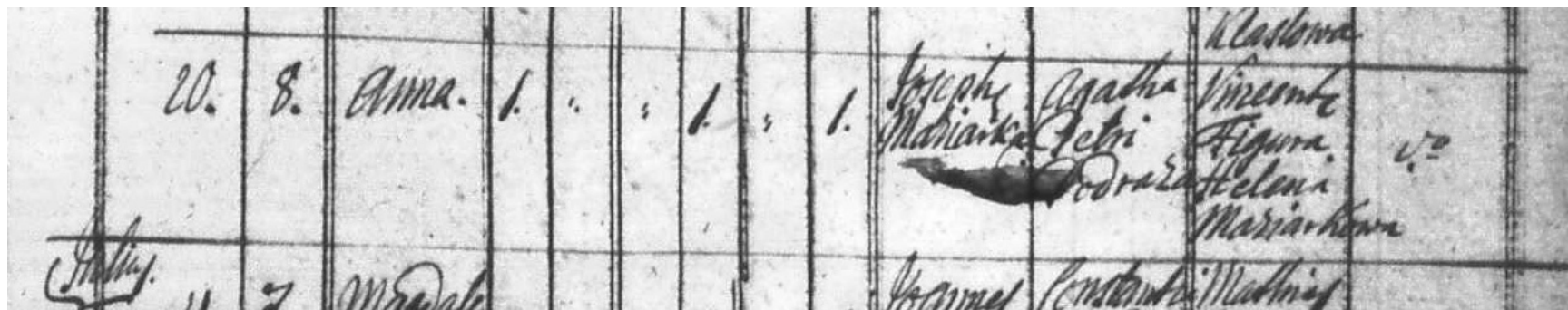

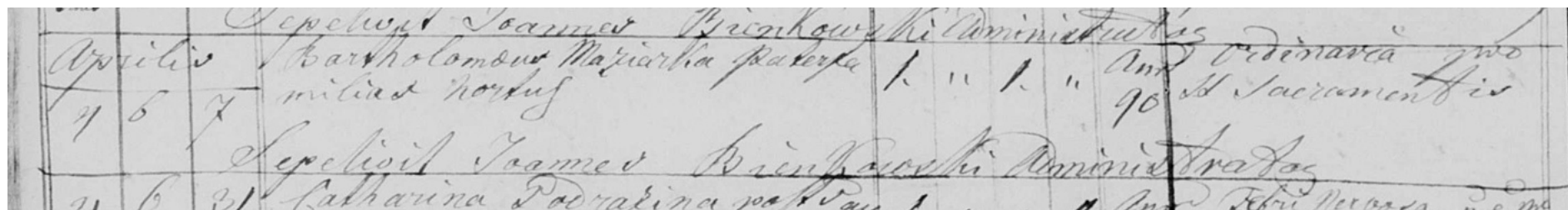
The Joseph and Agatha Maziarka family also lived at House #8 and would have been more directly associated with the new owner of the farm Stanley Maziarka.

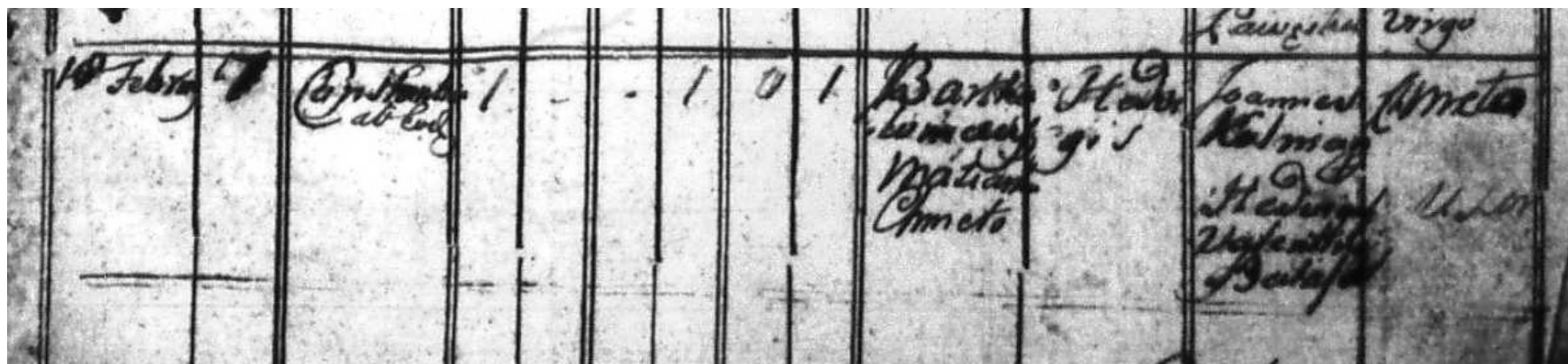
*Bartholomew Maziarka (House #7)*

Bartholomew Maziarka, whose wife was Hedwig, was the owner of House #7 prior to transfer of ownership to Paul Maziarka. The Paul Maziarka family was very close to both Valentine Maziarka (Clara's first husband) and Jacob Maziarka (Clara's second husband).

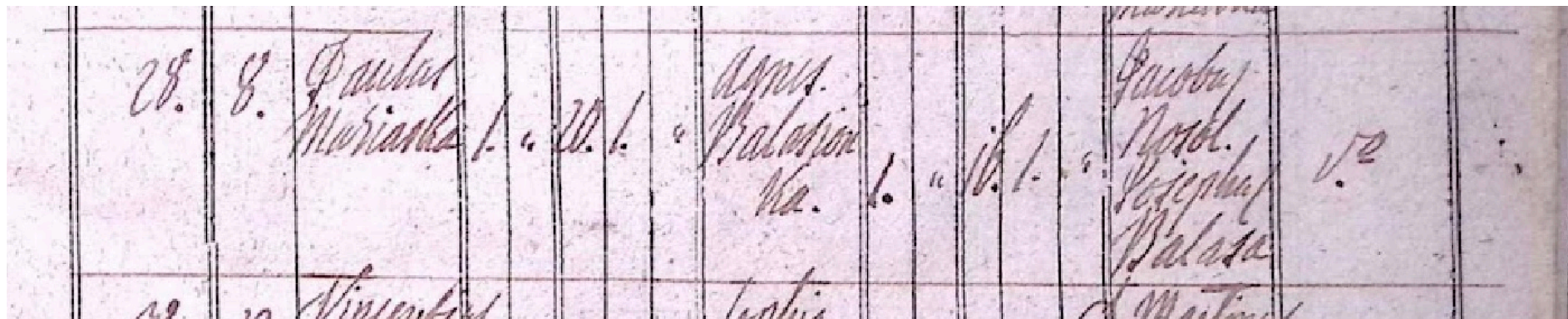

Paul Maziarka (House #7)

Paul Maziarka's parents appear to have been Bartholomew and Hedwig Maziarka. This would explain why he inherited the farm. He was married twice (Agnes Balasa and Regina Lis). Paul's first marriage was listed for House #8 during the time when Stanley Maziarka probably owned the farm.

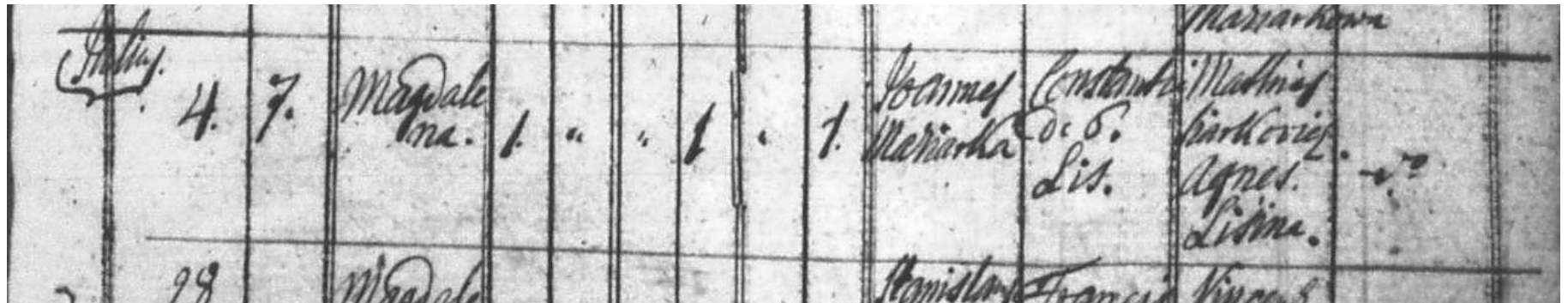

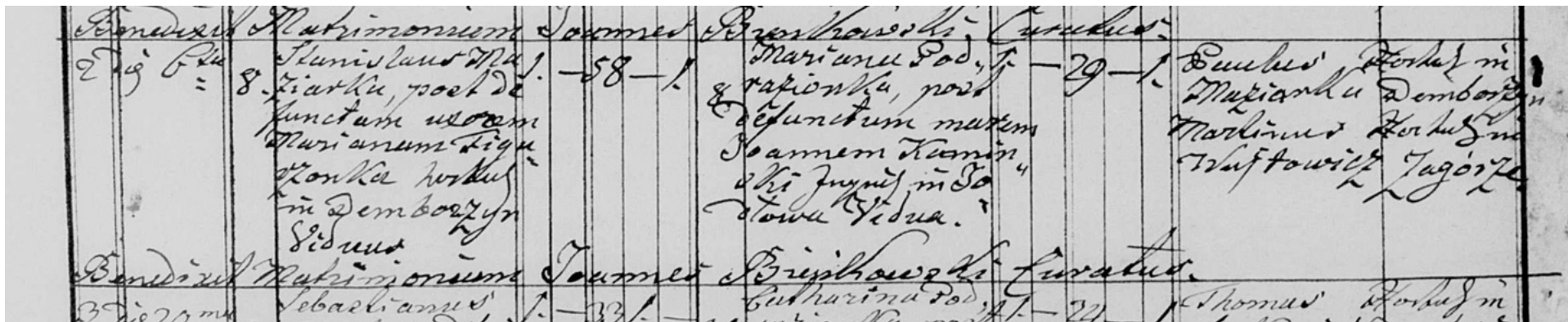
Stanley Maziarka (House #8)

House #8 was owned by Stanley Maziarka after John and Eva Maziarka left the farm to live at House #12. It is unknown when he acquired ownership. The Stanley Maziarka who lived at House #8 as of 1817 was the son of Bartholomew and Hedwig Maziarka from House #7. His first wife was Marianna Figura and second was also named Marianna with a slightly illegible maiden name. However, there is also a baptism whose mother was Marianna Lepa. It is possible there was more than one Stanley Maziarka who lived at House #8.



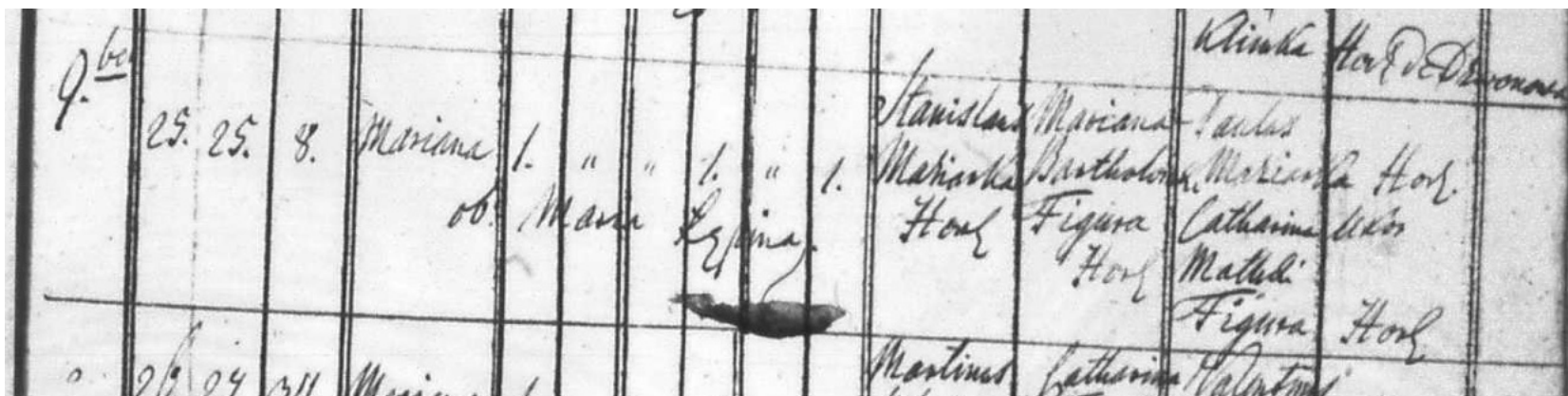
1817 Marriage of Stanley Maziarka

## **The Czarnawski Families of Dęborzyn**

Eva Maziarka, wife of John, served as godmother multiple times at Czarnawski baptisms. The family relationship has not been verified. It appears that House #22 in Dęborzyn was the common factor for these families. However, it is not possible to determine if Eva was a sister or cousin, or a daughter or niece.

Representative documents are shown below.

Eva (Czarnawski) Maziarka asked Regina Czarnawski to serve as godmother to one of her sons. She, in turn, was the godmother to a son of Jacob and Regina Czarnawski. It is unknown whether this was the same Regina Czarnawski. Records show a Jacob Czarnawski and Regina Maziarka family in Dęborzyn. It is unknown whether Regina Maziarka was related to Eva Czarnawski's husband John Maziarka.



House #22 was owned by Bartholomew Czarnawski who died in 1792. His wife appears to have been Catherine who died in 1805. It is possible that these are Eva Maziarka's parents. However, it is equally possible that Bartholomew was her uncle or that Catherine was a step-mother.

## Dęborzyn Land Records

A separate documentary was compiled for land records within the Przeczyca Parish that includes the Maziarka family in Dęborzyn.

The 1773 tax records (Fasje podatkowe) require further analysis, but would suggest village boundaries may have changed. Valentine Maziarka and Bartholomew Czarnawski, without addresses, were listed as farmers in a village immediately following Dęborzyn, but with a different name. It's possible that the second page is a continuation of Dęborzyn. There is a widow listed with a surname similar to Maziarka. Otherwise, these are the only Maziarka and Czarnawski entries.

Records for 1787-89 (Metryka Józefińska) show that House #8 in Dęborzyn was owned, or otherwise operated by, John Maziarka. House #7 was owned by Bartholomew Maziarka. However, Houses #10 and #12 were not owned by an individual with the Maziarka surname.

Records for 1820-1868 (Metryka Franciszkańska) show that House #8 was then owned by Stanley Maziarka and House #12 by Thomas Maziarka. House #7 was owned by Paul Maziarka and #10 by Michael Maziarka. All of these records match the church records.

The ownership transition between the Józefińska and Franciszkańska documents confirm what is expected for House #7 that involved a transfer from Bartholomew to Paul. Michael Maziarka gained ownership of House #10 that had not previously been associated with the family.

However, Houses #8 and #12 raise an uncertainty as to John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski. John was living at House #8 when his eldest children were born at the same time as the Józefińska documents were compiled. However, ownership transferred to Stanley Maziarka by the Franciszkańska era. Church records confirm that Stanley Maziarka lived on the farm.

It seems unlikely that John Maziarka (husband of Eva Czarnawski) would lose ownership of his own farm to another relative after he was already married with children. Therefore, it's possible that the John Maziarka mentioned in the Józefińska was a different individual with the same name, perhaps the husband of Francisca who died in 1791. Therefore, Stanley could be their son who inherited the farm. John and Eva Maziarka may have been relatives, but had to seek new opportunities after the transfer of ownership.

However, Thomas Maziarka owned House #12 when John and Eva Maziarka moved to that farm during the Franciszkańska era. Church records confirm that Thomas Maziarka lived on that farm. He died in 1822. John and Eva Maziarka were already living at House #12 by 1795. It is unclear who owned the farm at that time.

The 1850 Cadestral maps, which might have been derived from the earlier Franciszkańska records, show that Jacob Maziarka owned House #12. Clara Przybyło's second husband Jacob Maziarka died in 1852 and is probably the same person. John and Eva Maziarka did not own House #12 (at least not continuously), yet their daughter-in-law Clara Przybyło remained on the same farm after her first husband Valentine died throughout her entire second marriage until her own death. Therefore, John and Eva Maziarka's extended family must have acquired ownership of the farm as a result of the 1822 death of Thomas Maziarka. The exact family relationship remains unknown. Their son Valentine returned home from military service in 1820 and was married in 1821. Since his widow Clara spent her entire life after their marriage (including her remarriage) it would appear likely that Valentine Maziarka may have had an ownership interest of House #12. It is reasonable to conclude that he acquired ownership from a deceased relative (Thomas) in 1822. This interpretation is further supported because his parents were long-time residents of that farm.

The Józefińska records show that Bartholomew Czarnawski owned House #22. It appears that the only Czarnawski entry in the Franciszkańska documents was Lucy Czarnawski at House #22. Church records show that Bartholomew Czarnawski died at House #22 in 1792. Frank Czarnawski, whose wife was Lucy, died at House #22 in 1814. Therefore, the chronology of land ownership and church records match each other.

Despite very detailed land ownership records for the Maziarka and Czarnawski families in Dęborzyn, it is not possible to confidently or accurately identify the parents of either John Maziarka or his wife Eva Czarnawski.

## Additional Information

Michael E. Byczek, an Illinois attorney and managing real estate broker, has compiled original records for genealogy since 1992. John Maziarka and Eva Czarnawski are Michael E. Byczek's 5x-great-grandparents. Their son Valentine Maziarka (4x-great-grandfather) married Clara Przybylo in 1821. Their daughter Sophia Maziarka (3x-great-grandmother) married Martin Krul in 1860. Their daughter Victoria Król (2x-great-grandmother) married Adalbert Dudek in 1886. Their daughter Maryanna Dudek (great-grandmother) married Martin Byczek in Chicago at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their eldest child Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children. Michael E. Byczek is the eldest and was born in Bridgeport.
