Adalbert Przybylo and Frances Mroczek were married on 11/14/1773 in the Catholic church located in Pilzno (according to records). It appears that Adalbert was born about 1752.

They had a total of nine known children. It appears that all were born at House #17 Bielowy (Pilzno Parish):



The records prior to 1785 have not been verified and are based on transcriptions of the actual documents. Baptisms for this time period did not list date of birth.

Frank Przybylo married Barbara Bochenski in 1800. They are Michael E. Byczek's 5x-great-grandparents.

Adalbert Przybylo passed away on 7/28/1792 at House #17 Bielowy. His wife Frances was pregnant with their son Andrew, who was born four months later. The death record is presumed correct based on the address.

The death or possible remarriage of Frances (Mroczek) Przybylo has not been verified.



Their daughter Clara Przybylo (4x-great-grandmother) married Valentine Maziarka in 1821. Their daughter Sophia Maziarka (3x-great-grandmother) married Martin Krul in 1860. Their daughter Victoria Król (2x-great-grandmother) married Adalbert Dudek in 1886 at the Catholic church in Przeczyca. Their daughter Maryanna Dudek (great-grandmother) married Martin Byczek in Chicago, IL at St. Mary of Perpetual Help in the Bridgeport neighborhood in 1907. Their son Michael S. Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their eldest child Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children, Michael E. Byczek (the eldest) and Katherine S. Byczek, both born in Bridgeport.
